

Major Achievements since January 2015:

- **Finance:**
 - **Threefold increase in Capital expenditure - Rs 8516 crores(approx.) in 15-16 as compared to Rs 2885 crores in 14-15.**
 - Loan Agreement of Rs 103.664 Billion JPY has been signed with JICA on 31.3.2016.
 - Negotiation for EDFC-3 Project completed and loan amount of US\$ 650 Million sanctioned by World Bank on 30.06.2015.
 - DFC estimate Rs. 81,459 Crores approved by CCEA.
 - *CRISIL has reaffirmed the “CCR AAA (pronounced Corporate Credit Rating Triple A) rating to DFCCIL*

 - Contracts worth Rs. 28,765 crores as against 13000 crore worth contract finalized during last 6 years.

- **Progress of awarded works:**
 - **First goods train run between Durgawati-Sasaram on down-line in March 2016 and up-line in June, 2016.** Engine rolling of section was already done on 30.06.2015 after completion of Track & OHE Work.
 - **Trials of monitoring the progress of work through Drone has been conducted in 42 kms in WDFC & 56 kms in EDFC.**
 - Track linking with Mechanized track laying machine started at Bhadan, Maitha & Daudkhan in EDFC and at Bhagega in WDFC. Track linking of 290 km in EDFC & WDFC completed.
 - **Five-fold increase in progress of Earthwork & Concreting in Rewari-Iqbalgarh section of WDFC as well as in Khurja-Kanpur section of EDFC.**
 - Sone Bridge between Dehri-on-Sone & Sonenagar is the largest bridge (3060 mtr) to be constructed on DFCC system. Overall progress is 77% till date.
 - Due to constant persuasion with State Governments, they have agreed to share cost of ROBs on 50:50 basis. This has resulted in consent for 121 ROBs from 9 different states received, leading to savings of Rs 2400 crores approx. to Ministry of Railways.
 - First junction arrangement with Indian Railways commissioned in June, 15.
 - Sleeper plant at Bhagega in WDFC commissioned.
 - Sleeper production in EDFC expedited from 1000/day to 1500/day.

- **Environmental clearances received.**
 - Permission under Aravali Eco-sensitive zone granted for Both Rajasthan and Haryana subject to 2nd stage forest clearance.
 - Stage- 2 clearance under Forest Conservation Act for 141 Ha in 4 states of Western DFC & 175.168 Ha in 2 states of Eastern DFC received during the year.
 - Stage- 1 clearance under Forest Conservation Act for 5.6779 Ha in Gujarat in Western DFC & 3.4078 Ha in Gaya in Eastern DFC received during the year.
 - Permission from Mumbai High Court for cutting of mangroves.
 - NOC from Archeological Survey of India for construction through protected land in Greater Noida.
 - Approval of Dahanu Taluka Environment Protection Authority (DTEPA) obtained in June 2015.
 - Permission for felling of trees near Sanjay Gandhi National Park obtained from NGT, Pune.
 - Coastal Regulatory Zone clearance in Thane & Raigarh districts received.
 - 25000 trees planted by Forest department in lieu of 4314 trees in TTZ area in EDFC.
 - Cumulative Impact Assessment (CIA) study for EDFC was conducted.

- **Other Achievements**

- DFCCIL Corporate Office Building was awarded with 5***** rating by BEE, Ministry of Power.
- Project Saksham - Skill development training of 1000 PAPs/BPL persons leading to employment building was completed in association with CII during 2015-16.
